# Story time! - the Good Samaritan


There once lived a lawyer and he went and asked Jesus ,What can I do to have eternal life.




And then Christ asked this lawyer "what is written in the bible".








As the man was left hurt on the ground, there were two people who came one after the other, first there was a priest who passed him, and he left him without offering any help
