


# **FRACTALS PART 2**

# **Memory Text**

## Psalm 89:13

Thou hast a mighty arm; strong is thy hand, and high is thy right hand.



There are four spaces between your fingers and these are the four dispensations. We see a repeating pattern in every dispensation.

Do you still remember the repeating pattern?

A new message is given.

People understand the message. People begin to share the message. We can also call this repeating pattern: **Boston** Concord Exeter We get these names from the Millerites History The Millerites are a group of people that God was leading out of darkness. We will learn more about them and see what happened in their journey. We get a lot of lessons from them because God's dealing with man are ever the same. By looking back at how others travelled on their journey where God was leading them out of darkness we can avoid making the same mistakes that they made and we can see many repeating patterns. Boston is the opening up of a new message. Samuel Snow was one of the Millerites. He received a new message called The True Midnight Cry Message and presented it in a place called Boston.



Samuel Snow gave the same message again in Concord. People understood the message better.

Concord means unity or agreement. This is the Increase of knowledge. The message is understood.



Exeter is related with time. This is the formalization.

People become very sure about the message and they begin to share more with others.

Samuel Snow gave the <u>True midnight cry message</u> the third time in Exeter and here in Exeter the message shone brighter and people began to share with their families and friends.
