

Histories of Success

When God starts to gather a people, messengers are raised up.

If the Second Angel corrects the mistakes of the First Angel, then the history is success.



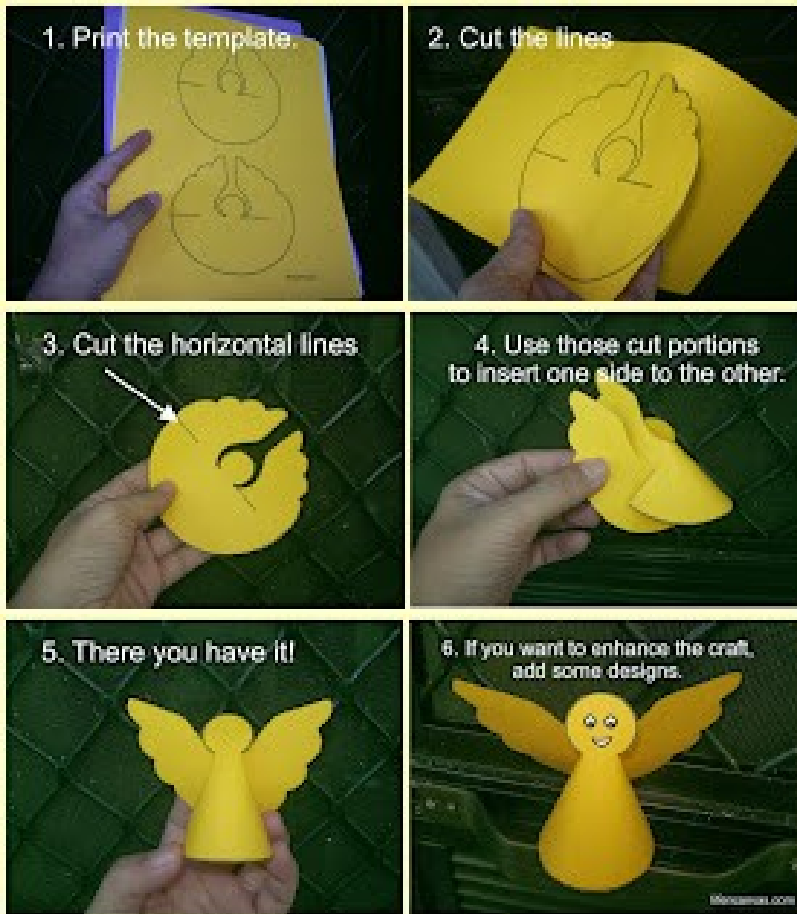
There are two histories where the Second Angel corrected the mistakes of the First Angel. These are The End of Ancient Israel, and The End of Modern Israel.
