Lucifer in heaven, before his rebellion, was a high and exalted angel, next in honor to God's dear Son. His countenance, like those of the other angels, was mild and expressive of happiness. His forehead was high and broad, showing a powerful intellect. His form was perfect; his bearing noble and majestic. A special light beamed in his countenance and shone around him brighter and more beautiful than around the other angels; **yet** Christ, God's dear Son, had the pre-eminence over all the angelic host. He was one with the Father before the angels were created. Lucifer was envious of Christ, and gradually assumed command which devolved on Christ alone. SR 13.1

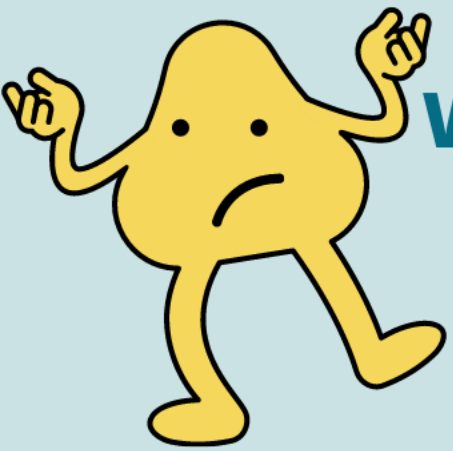


WHAT DOES THE WORD ,YET , MEAN

YET : Is a word which joins two sentences together

A word which joins two sentences together is called a **CONJUNCTION** ,it also means **but** or **nevertheless** and we use it for comparison

So when we see the word **Yet** we can know that there is a comparison.
And we compare two things or objects
So the two people we are comparing are **LUCIFER AND CHRIST**

COMPARE

This means to look for similarities (same) between two people or objects

Example: What are the similarities in these 2 images



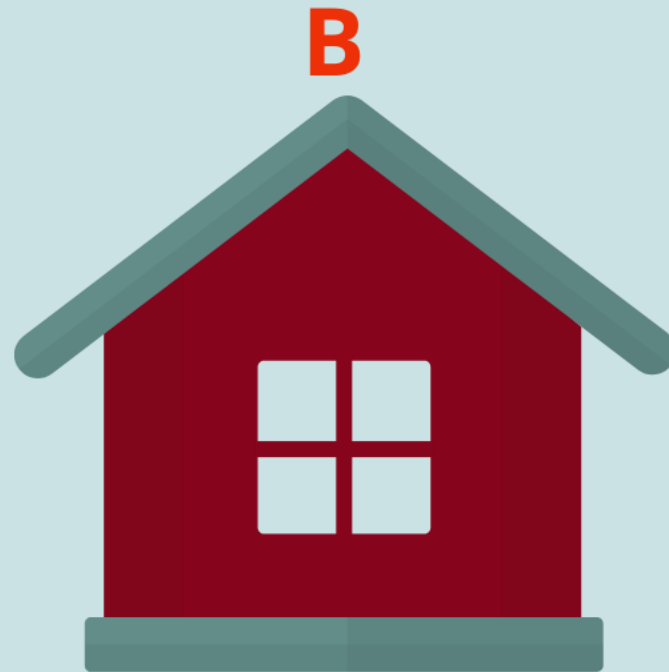
CLUES

In the chapter we are not told what Christ looks like but by comparing and contrasting we can also learn of him. Lucifer compares what he has in common with Christ and contrasts what is different ,And he sees that he is more beautiful than Christ based on :

- ★ Countenance[the appearance or expression of someone]
- ★ Forehead[the flat part of the face, above the eyes and below the hair:]
- ★ Form[be something]
- ★ Noble [admiration because of a particular appearance or quality]
- ★ Light radiating

From this story we learn that the outward appearance of someone should not determine whether or not they should dominate someone else

If a boy /man has a better and stronger appearance than that of a girl/woman that doesn't mean he should dominate her. And if someone has different skin colour than someone else that doesn't mean that ,that person should dominate the other person who has another skin colour that does not look like theirs .
